Admission Requirements

- Bachelor's degree or equivalent,
- The candidate must have proficiency in English language. When the candidate is a not a native English speaker, has not completed a degree in English, or has not worked in English, the prospective student must have a TOEFL score of 500PBT/61IBT (or equivalent score in an equivalent English test).

Admissions Process

1. Application

First you must apply by filling in the application form, and sending Horizons University all the required documentation either via email or post.

2. Application Apraisal
