### The Master in French

This program is designed for students who already master the French language and wish to take their experience and knowledge one step further.

Introductory and advanced courses will cover the linguistic and cultural aspects. Students will gain in-depth knowledge about the French environment, improve their writing and oral skills and learn to evolve confidently and efficiently in a professional French environment.

### **Career Prospects**

Graduates will be able to apply for positions in the publishing industry, in education, tourism, foreign languages (translator, interpreter) and key communication positions in international organizations.

## **Admission Requirements**

- Bachelor's degree or equivalent.
- The candidate must have proficiency in French language. When the candidate

is a not a native French speaker, has not completed a degree in French, or has not worked in French, the prospective student must have a pass score in a French language test.

### Methodology

The program follows two roads: one focused on introductory courses in language (grammar, translation) and generic courses in French civilization; and another more specific road focusing on the particular aspects of French culture and society.

Students must write a thesis, which is a 30-to 40-page paper on a topic selected by the student and subject to approval. Students are encouraged to make a proposal during their first term. The thesis is a creative or research-based document entirely written in French.


# Flexible, self-paced, 100% online

### **Admissions Process**

### 1. Application

First you must apply by filling in the application form, and sending Horizons University all the required documentation either via email or post.

### 2. Application Apraisal

Once you have submited your complete application, Admissions will appraise your application and get back to you in one week with the results of the evaluation.

### 3. Enrollment to the University

Once accepted you will be elegible to enroll. The enrollment process is simple and fast. At this point you are required to send an original copy of your latest transcript to the central Paris campus, and pay your tuition. ### **Supporting Documents for Application**

- Your resume (Curriculum Vitae).
- 1 passport-size photo
- Scanned copies of all diplomas and transcripts obtained to date
- Proof of language proficiency
- Copy of your passport.

### **Application and Enrollment Dates**

You may enroll to the Master in French 365 days a year.

Once accepted, you can enroll to Master in French program anytime, and begin your courses any day, because courses have enrollment on a rolling basis.

### Graduation

Diplomas are shipped upon successful completion of the degree. Students wishing to attend graduation on our campus should contact the university at least 6 months prior to graduation (every Summer).
